MARYLAND SPORTING DOG ASSOCIATION SPRING FIELD DAY MAY 2, 2020

Registration is now open for MSDA's Field Day, a full FUN day of training for all levels of bird dogs. Field Day is scheduled for Saturday, May 2nd at Rebel Ridge Farms in Elkton MD. That's about six weeks from now. There will be training groups for flushing, pointing, and retrieving breeds; each of these will be divided further into at least beginning and advanced sections. There also will be opportunities for very experienced handlers to "work on your own". In addition, we're planning CGC testing, a stand-up seminar on the use of e-collars in field training, information for those interested in gunning for hunt tests and field trials, a raffle, and of course our famous potluck lunch buffet. Whether you are a total beginner or an experienced handler with titled bird dogs, Field Day will have something for you!

Already we have 29 dogs signed up, representing the following breeds: Barbet, Curly-Coated Retriever, English Cocker Spaniel, English Springer Spaniel, Field Spaniel, Flat Coated Retriever, German Shorthaired Pointer, German Wirehaired Pointer, Golden Retriever, Labrador Retriever, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever, Weimaraner, Welsh Springer Spaniel, and Wirehaired Pointing Griffon, with many more expected.
